These surveys were conducted on the telephone by trained interviewers among voters throughout Queensland. Telephone numbers and the person within the household were selected at random. The data has been weighted to reflect the population distribution of Queensland. In the latest survey, voting intention questions are based on 755 interviews after the formation of the Liberal National Party, and leadership questions are based on 1,132 interviews. The maximum margin of sampling error on the voting intention questions is plus or minus 3.6 percentage points, and plus or minus 3 percentage points on the leadership questions.
