These polls were conducted on the telephone over the period of 18-20 June 2010 by trained interviewers among 1,800 voters. Areas covered by the survey are a) the Queensland federal electorates of Dawson, Flynn and Longman which were polled as a single stratified sample. b) Page (New South Wales) and c) Lindsay (New South Wales). Telephone numbers and the person within the household were selected at random. The data has been weighted to reflect the population distribution. Electorate sample sizes are 600 in Queensland (spread evenly over the three electorates), 600 in Page, and 600 in Lindsay. The maximum margin of sampling error is approximately plus or minus 4 percentage points on the total of the three Queensland electorates, and in each of Page and Lindsay.
